

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HAMPTON ORDINANCE NO. 5-1

WATER ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

An Ordinance for the purpose of amending Ordinance No. 4, being the Water Ordinance of the Charter Township of Hampton, Bay County, Michigan, and to provide for the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of persons or property within the Charter Township of Hampton, Bay County, Michigan.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Charter Township of Hampton, Bay County, Michigan, ordains:

Section 1 - Short Title

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Water Ordinance Amendment Ordinance."

Section 2 - Amendment to Ordinance No. 4, Section 17

Section 17 of Ordinance No. 4 is amended to read in full as follows:

"The Township Board shall from time to time fix all rates, assessments and charges for the supply or use of any water. Bills will be rendered monthly or quarterly, at the discretion of the Township Board, and payable at the Township Hall or other places designated by the Township Board. A delayed payment charge will be applied to unpaid balances as determined from time to time by the Township Board."

Section 3 - Amendment to Ordinance No. 4, Section 27

Section 27 of Ordinance No. 4 is amended to read in full as follows:

"Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. Each day in which such violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense."

Section 4 - Penalty

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. Each day in which such violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 5 - Separability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 6 - Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7 - Emergency Ordinance Declaration

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance.

Section 8 - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication thereof.
